

SCIENCE LABORATORY PROJECT AT TIBETAN NEHRU MEMORIAL FOUNDATION SCHOOL, CLEMENT TOWN

Background Information



The Tibetan Nehru Memorial Foundation School (TNMFS) is a Kindergarten to Grade 12 Tibetan school located in the Tibetan settlement at Clement Town, N India. It is also the school attended by the children of Kyitsel-ling Tibetan Children's Education Center - TCEF's partner organization.

TNMFS is owned and administered by the Tibetan community at Clement Town. Although it comes under the broad overall jurisdiction of the Tibetan Department of Education at Dharamsala, it is categorized as an Autonomous school and receives very little funding — almost no funding for infrastructure over the past 10 years. As a result, the school has very little financial resources and over the years TCEF has helped whenever possible.

The Need for a Science Room

Science is one of the core subjects studied in this school right from grade 1. However, due to financial constraints, the school has never had a Science Lab and the school administration again requested TCEF's help. TCEF board member Jennifer Prugh visited the school, saw the need first hand and reached out to her circle of friends for help.

In April 2018, the school completed all the needed renovations, purchase of supplies and installation of equipment. The inauguration of the Science Lab was attended by TCEF Executive Director Karma Tensum along with other local dignitaries.
