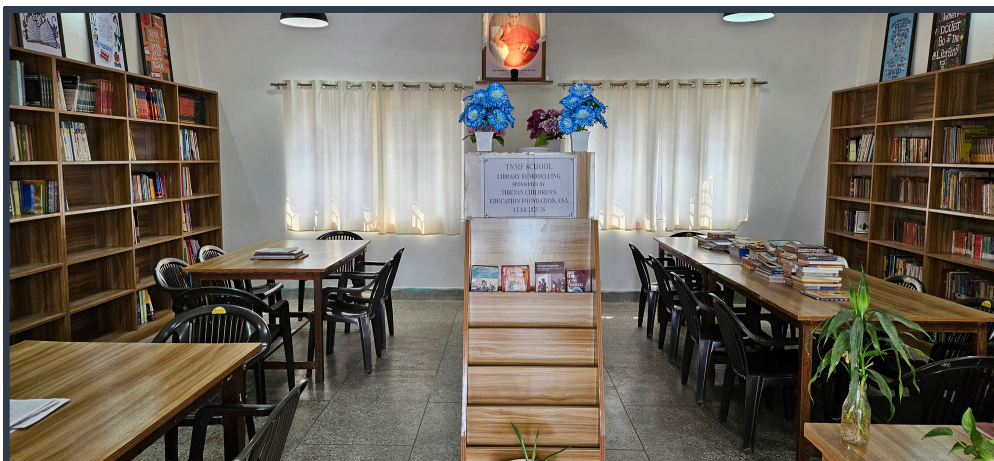
TNMF School Library Renovation Project

1. Project Overview

— What the project was and why it mattered

The Library Renovation Project at TNMF School has been successfully completed with the generous support of our valued sponsors. TNMF School serves approximately 170 students, many of whom come from Tibetan and Himalayan communities. Prior to renovation, the library required significant improvements in infrastructure, furniture, technology, and learning resources. Through this project, the library has been revitalized into a welcoming, technology-enabled, and resource-rich environment that will benefit students and staff for many years to come.

The renovated library now serves as a central academic space where students can access books, digital resources, educational technology, and a comfortable reading environment that supports both classroom learning and personal development.

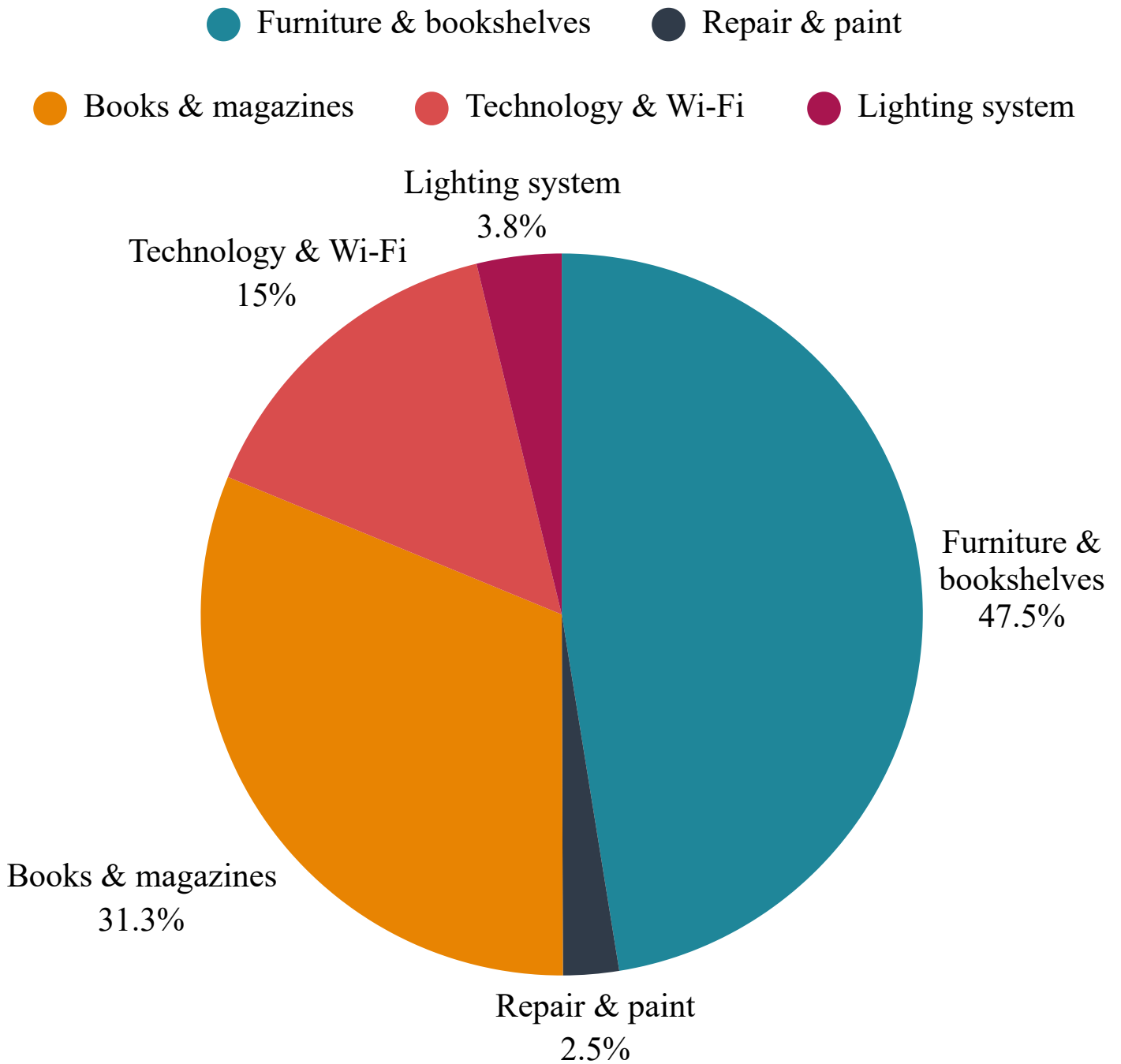

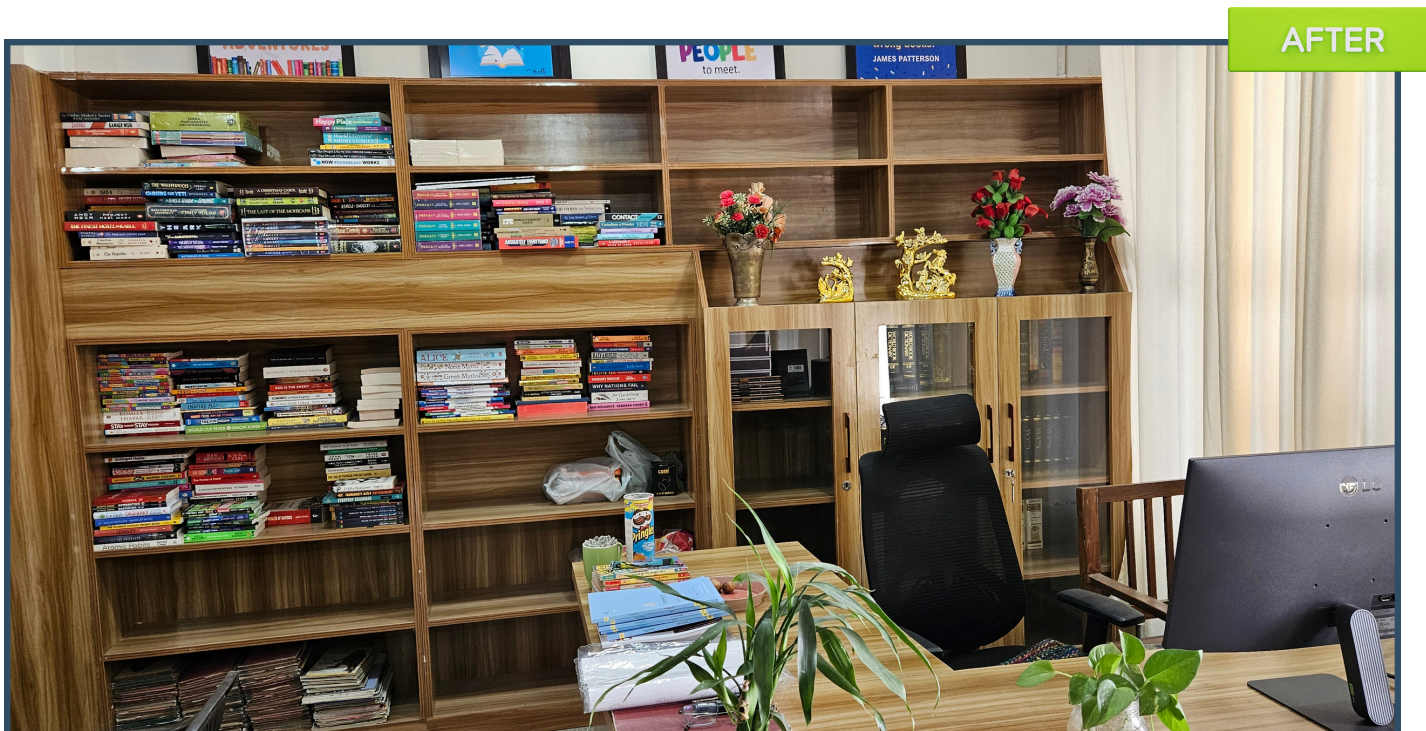
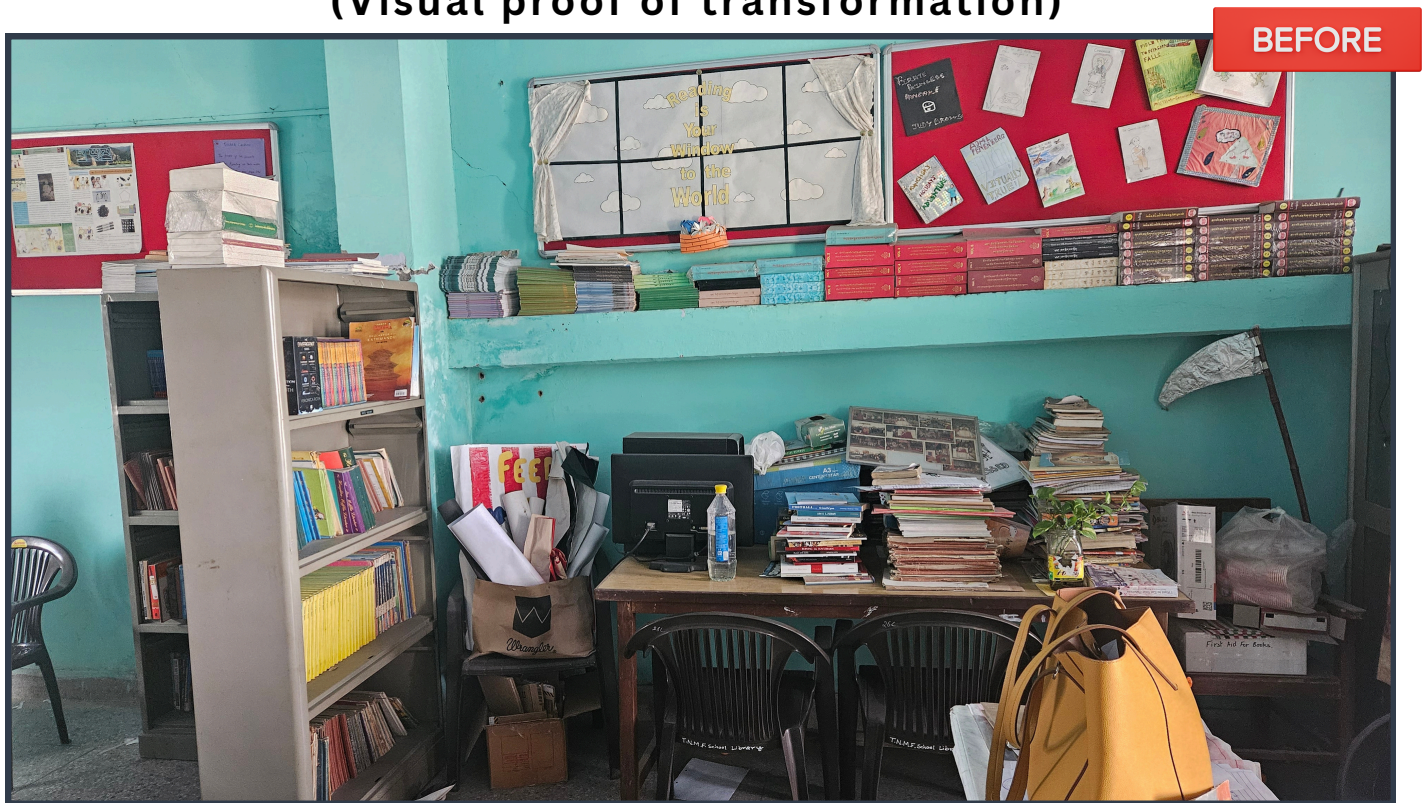
